CURRENTLY WE ARE IN THE PROCESS OF FIXING A MAJOR ROOF LEAK IN THE CENTER AT A COST OF **\$18,000** AND NEED TO DO A RENOVATION ON THE MEN'S CLUB PAVILION TO ATTRACT MORE RENTERS WHICH IS ESTIMATED TO COST BETWEEN **\$16,000** AND **\$20,000**.
