The third Sunday of Pascha is dedicated to the myrrhbearing women who cared for the body of Christ at his death and who were the first witnesses of his Resurrection.

The Myrrh-bearers are traditionally listed as:[

Mary Magdalene

Mary, the mother of James and Joses

Mary, the wife of Cleopas

Martha of Bethany, Sister of Lazarus

Mary of Bethany, Sister of Lazarus

Joanna, the wife of Chuza the steward of Herod Antipas

Salome, the mother of James and John, the sons of Zebedee

Susanna

Troparion — Tone 2

The angel came to the myrrhbearing women at the tomb and said: / Myrrh is meet for the dead; / but Christ has shown Himself a stranger to corruption! / So proclaim: The Lord is risen, / granting the world great mercy!

Kontakion — Tone 2

When You proclaimed “Rejoice” to the Myrrhbearers, / You caused the lamentation of the first mother Eve to cease by Your Resurrection; O Christ God; / You bade Your Apostles to preach: / “The Savior is risen from the tomb.”
