The Sunday of the Blind Man

The sixth Sunday commemorates the healing of the man blind from birth. The Gospel of St John tells how Jesus used clay of spittle and told the man to wash in the waters of Siloam. He did so because it was the Sabbath day on which spitting, clay-making and washing were strictly forbidden. By breaking these ritual laws of the Jews, Jesus showed that he is indeed the Lord of the Sabbath, and, as such, that he is equal to God the Father Who alone, according to Jewish tradition, works on the Sabbath day in running his world.

A reminder that the Lord has anointed our eyes with his own divine hands and washed them with the waters of our baptism.
